### ***An Evening with the Friends...* Program Chair Volunteer**

Friends of Smyrna Library (FOSL), an independent, non-profit, volunteer Organization that supports the award winning Smyrna Public Library through fundraising events and volunteer activities, is seeking ***An Evening with the Friends...* Program Chair Volunteer**.

*An Evening with the Friends...* is an annual holiday event sponsored by FOSL. It takes place on the first Saturday evening in December. The event is best described as an elegant and well-organized celebration of the Smyrna Public Library by the FOSL organization's membership.

Over the years the event has featured live performances of classical music, holiday-themed literature readings and gourmet desserts/coffees amid a fun atmosphere of camaraderie and sophistication. We have also leveraged the event for targeted donation drives. Example: Attendees donated more than \$1000 in movie DVDs that were added to the library's collection one year.

In April 2010 the FOSL President and the FOSL Board of Directors approved a motion to decentralize program and event leadership to carefully vetted current FOSL members who wish to be more actively involved. Ultimately this strategy will enable FOSL to provide more programs to more effectively support the library and enable greater FOSL member participation.

FOSL now seeks a creative and dynamic volunteer **Program Chair** to lead, organize, direct and deliver the best ever *An Evening with the Friends...* program for 2010. This volunteer effort is expected to require a 15-25 hour total time commitment through December.

The selected leader for this program will also work closely with the FOSL Organization Officers, FOSL Public Relations Director, Program Chair for the *FOSL Holiday Wreath Silent Auction* and the *FOSL Book Sale Committee* who will be coordinating a sale of "gift quality" books to coincide with this event.
